

Dear colleagues,

Brussels Airport Company has published the NOTAM A4394/25 and Brussels South Charleroi Airport has published the NOTAM A4385/25

A day of national industrial action is announced in Belgium on Wednesday 26 November.

It is already known that many operational partners at Brussels Airport and Brussels South Charleroi Airport will be heavily impacted, and capacity provided by handling agent will be limited.

Belgium Slot Coordination (BSC) confirms that we will grant JNUS/Force majeure on the usage of airport slots for all flights cancelled in advance of the day of the strike.

We ask airlines who will cancel flights to do this without delay, before the day of operation, and indicate in the SI line of the SCR message "Cancelled because of industrial actions 26NOV"
